### 1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The prescriptions of the Italian Sailing Authority (FIV) will apply and will be stated in full in the sailing instructions.
- 1.3 In so far as the IMCA has not yet resolved all the issues relating to the use of hydrofoils, the Sailing Instructions will stipulate a one configuration principle applying to hydrofoils, specifically that: 'Any International Moth using a hydrofoil device intended to lift the hull out of the water and thus reduce wetted surface area when racing shall retain the device on the boat, whether used or not, for all races that constitute the series, unless dispensation from this rule is granted by the Race Committee on request by the competitor in writing.' Also the Sailing Instructions will make use of the provision of Rule 86 to stipulate that 'RRS 52 shall not apply to non-motorized devices used to adjust hydrofoils.' If there is a conflict between this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions will take precedence.
- 1.4 RRS 63.3 will be changed to provide that only the skipper or crew may represent a boat at protest hearings.

### 2 ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Advertising will be restricted to Category C.
- 2.2 Boats may be required to display Event Advertising on the forward part of the hull.
- 2.3 According to the Italian Law, advertising for alcoholic beverages and for tobacco products is prohibited.

### 3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to boats of the International Moth class and helmspersons who are members of any IMCA national authority in Europe or anywhere in the world.
- 3.2 Each sailor shall produce a National Authority membership card and an IMCA membership card.
- 3.3 The chartered or borrowed boats shall be eligible to compete provided details are included with their entry form.
- 3.4 The helmsman named on the boat entry form shall be the same for all races in the regatta
- 3.5 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and sending it to [info@vccampione.org](mailto:info@vccampione.org) or by fax to: +39-0365-916908 from 17 July 2005.

#### **4 SAIL AND BOW NUMBERS**

**4.1** Each boat shall show the sail number and national letters as indicated on the Official Entry Form.

#### **5 FEES**

**5.1** Required fees are € 100 . It can be paid by cash or by visa/mastercard credit cards.

**5.2** Every day there will be the possibility to have lunch and dinner at the clubhouse with special prices for the competitors.

#### **6 SCHEDULE**

**6.1** Registration:

**6.4** The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is 14:00

#### **7 MEASUREMENTS**

Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate. The Race Committee or the IMCA European Championship Committee may inspect or measure any boat at any time.

#### **8 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

The sailing instructions will be available from 14:00 on Tuesday 2 August at the race office.

#### **9 VENUE**

Attachment A shows the location of the racing area.

#### **10 THE COURSES**

The courses to be sailed will be Moth "p" or "d" course and one long range course.

#### **11 PENALTY SYSTEM**

The rules 44.1 and 44.2 are changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one gybe, is required.

#### **12 SCORING**

**12.1** 5 races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

**12.2** (a) When fewer than 6 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When from 7 to 8 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

- (c) When 9 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

### **13 PRIZES**

Prizes will be awarded as follows:

- 13.1** International Moth Class European Champion, awarded to the overall first placed european sailor
- 13.2** Campione Speed Cup Trophy, awarded to the overall first placed sailor
- 13.3** Overall Placing – 2<sup>nd</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> keepsake trophies
- 13.4** International Moth Class European Masters Champion, awarded to the first placed sailor aged 34 years or older as of 1<sup>st</sup> August 2005, from an European country
- 13.5** International Moth Class European Junior Champion, awarded to the first placed sailor aged 18 years or under as of 1<sup>st</sup> August 2005, from an European country
- 13.6** First Open Hydrofoil, awarded to the overall first placed hydrofoil Moth
- 13.7** First Skiff, awarded to the overall first placed non-hydrofoil skiff hulled Moth
- 13.8** First Female, awarded the overall highest placed female sailor

### **14 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

### **15 INSURANCE**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of not less than € 3.000.000 per event or the equivalent.

The race organisers and the IMCA shall not be responsible for any loss, damage, death or personal injury however caused to the owner/competitor or crew as a result of their taking part in a race or races. Moreover, every owner/competitor warrants the suitability of his or her boat for the race or races and is solely responsible for his or her decision whether or not to sail and compete in the weather conditions prevailing at the time.
